Pass is good at Airport, Champions, Mentel Memorial, Raymond Memorial, Turnberry, and Wilson Road Golf Courses. Pass holders DO NOT have any preference over daily greens fee players for tee times. Not valid for league play and/or outings.

PLEASE NOTE: The Columbus Golf Pass is not transferable and identification may be required at the Pro Shop and there are NO REFUNDS on passes. Acceptable forms of payment are: Cash, Checks (made payable to Columbus Treasurer-Golf), or credit card. Gift Cards may not be used for purchasing Columbus Golf Passes.

CODE OF CONDUCT

All participants, guests, and attendees are expected to conduct themselves in a respectful and responsible manner at all times while on the premises of any City of Columbus Recreation and Parks Department Golf Course, including the clubhouse, practice areas, parking lot, and course grounds.

Golf Course Management and Staff reserves the right to dismiss any individual or group from the premises at any time, without refund, for conduct deemed inappropriate, unsafe, disruptive, or in violation of course policies or city regulations.

Unacceptable behavior includes, but is not limited to:

- Disorderly conduct, including verbal abuse, physical altercations, or harassment of staff, volunteers, or other participants, patrons, customers, or spectators.
- Public intoxication or excessive alcohol consumption that interferes with the safety or enjoyment of others
- Possession or consumption of outside alcohol, which is strictly prohibited by Ohio Law and the City of Columbus Recreation and Parks Department
- Rough use, vandalism or damage to course property, golf carts, signage, greens, or any area of the facility
- Possession of a firearm(s)
- Possession or use of illegal substances or engaging in criminal behavior
- Obscene, discriminatory, or offensive language, gestures, or clothing
- Failure to comply with pace-of-play guidelines, staff instructions, or posted rules and regulations
- Violations of any policies established by the City of Columbus Recreation and Parks Department Golf Courses

All posted course rules and city regulations must be followed at all times. Violations of these policies may result in immediate removal from the facility, with no refund or compensation provided.

By participating, all individuals acknowledge and agree to abide by this Code of Conduct and the rules of this agreement, the City of Columbus Recreation and Parks Department, and the host golf course.
